



## Legal Advice and Legal Aid

Macarthur Legal Centre's Outreach is a service that has been providing free legal advice to community members in suburbs such as Macquarie Fields, Airds, Tharawal, Claymore and Wollondilly.

This service is particularly programmed to allow community members in Wollondilly to access free legal advice from our Legal Centre who would otherwise find it difficult to access our Centre in Campbelltown.

The outreach enables Wollondilly residents to receive face-to-face legal advice without having to travel too far from the local area. The consistency of the service also means that clients can book appointments on the day to receive a regular update for their ongoing legal cases. This also means that residents in Wollondilly can receive legal advice quickly and confidentially. It's all about bringing the services of Macarthur Legal Centre to your doorstep.

The free legal advice service is provided to anyone living in the Wollondilly area provided your legal matter is covered by our Legal Centre. The legal areas covered by our Centre include Credit and Debt, Discrimination Law, Family Law, Wills, Power of Attorney and Guardianship, Fines, Consumer Complaints, Centrelink, Victims Compensation and Employment Law. You can seek assistance from our Centre if you would like general legal information, if you need to know your rights or simply would like to discuss your legal problem with a solicitor.
