The service assists people through their financial crisis and in developing money-managing skills for long-term rehabilitation.

In today's society financial problems can happen to anyone. You may be facing financial problems caused by factors beyond your control. It is best to seek help as soon as possible so these problems don't get out of control.

We can help you if you are in financial difficulty, in a financial crisis or wish to avoid financial difficulties. You may be

- having difficulty paying debts
- being harassed by creditors or debt collectors
- facing legal action regarding your debts
- dealing with car repossession
- worried about being evicted from your home
- having difficulties in managing money or budgeting.

Most financial problems get worse unless you seek help. Financial counseling can help relieve stress by assisting you to deal with your financial problems.
